

The Volkswagen Transporter's reputation for quality, reliability and durability is legendary. And it goes on getting better as the years roll by. Take the 1989 Camping version used as the base for Richard Holdsworth's award winning Villa and Vision motor caravans.

Attractive new front-end with dual headlights. Moulded bumpers both front and rear with front spoiler. At the back there's a heated rear window with wash/wipe facility. Inside there's an intermittent wipe for the front windscreen. Cigar lighter. Vanity mirror with courtesy light. Plus child proof locks for the rear sliding door.

The Villa and the executive class Vision high top just keep on getting better too. (Perhaps that's why Richard Holdsworth has picked up Motor Caravan of the Year awards in both '87 and '88.)

For 1989, you'll immediately be attracted to the beautiful new fabrics. Floral tapestry complemented by expensive dralons. Deep plum coloured curtains and 'split' rear cushions for greater rear passenger comfort.

But it's the basics as well as the beauty that attracts more and more motor caravanners to the Villa and Vision.

Richard Holdsworth designers know that a second battery is essential if your motor caravan isn't to get that let down feeling. So the Villa and Vision

both have dual batteries as standard along with mains hook-up and split charger.

Then there's that marvellous German rock-and-roll mechanism for the easiest bed/seat operation in the business while rear seat restraints now become a standard fitting.

Then there's the way in which all Richard Holdsworth motor caravans are built. Proper plywood in place of chipboard. Solid beech cappings to all worktops and door handles that are hand carved from solid timber too. Full length brass piano hinges and door catches that won't fly open on the first corner.

The Volkswagen Transporter plus the Richard Holdsworth Villa and Vision conversions. We just keep on getting better and better...

The Villa is available as a non-roof conversion and with a height of just 6ft 6in suits owners with garaging problems. It is also available with the patented, one-action solid sided elevating roof or Volkswagen's own high top giving full standing height from the rear into the vehicle cab. The executive class Vision is available only with the Volkswagen high top.
